Love is the key to all things. This has been a constant reminder from the Teachers on the Higher Planes of Love and Light and also the message Jesus brought when he walked this earth plane. The Love we speak of here is Divine Love; God's Love.

Love is the essence of God. Love is the motivating factor in life. Without Love life would have no meaning, no purpose. So many lose their purpose in life because they have lost the ability to love, or never really had it. Sometimes, we are afraid to love because we are afraid we might get hurt, we fear rejection. Through fear we limit our love.

Fear is the opposite of Love and in True Reality there is nothing to fear. Fear, then, is made up of the substance of illusion and has no basis in Reality. Fear is a temporary departure from the Truth.

All so-called problems in the world are cloaked in fear or illusion. When fear is removed there is no problem. Fear and Love cannot abide in the same place

no more than Light and darkness can. If we learn to Love and really let Love have Its way in our life; in our every thought, word and deed, we cannot have fear in our life. When there is no fear, then there are no problems!

The word love in our society is used quite loosely and has many different connotations. Because of the various definitions of love we often become confused and unhappy in our relationships with those we love.

The majority of us on this earth plane have a very limited, possessive idea of the meaning of love. We put conditions on love and have expectations of love and our loved ones. Unconditional love is the only True Love. Loving for Love Itself, giving freely of ourself, loving without expecting anything in return is Love...Divine Love.
